

STANDARDISED PRICE LIST

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<p>ATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as they attend their burial or cremation. (Funeral director's charges only)</p>	£2325
Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements	£950
Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death within hours 9am-5pm (within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£275
Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. (for up to 25 days)	£350
Visiting the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£0
At a date and time you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in an appropriate vehicle (hire of hearse at additional cost).	£300
<p>UNATTENDED FUNERAL This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.</p>	
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee)	£1550
Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1500

We also have available a breakdown of more fees. We like to encourage families to arrange funerals as they wish to, allowing families to cherry pick the services they require from us.

ADDITIONAL FUNERAL DIRECTOR PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

This funeral director may be able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them.

Examples include:

Additional mileage (price per mile) £1

Collection and delivery of ashes, in crematorium supplied £40 biodegradable container. (other options available)

Embalming Not usually required £155

Funeral officiant (e.g. celebrant, minister of religion etc.) Estimated £250

Services supplied outside of normal office hours. Prices upon request

The funeral director can give you a full list of what they can supply. They are likely to charge for these additional products and services, so you may choose to take care of some arrangements without their involvement, or you can use a different supplier, for example printed orders of service, newspaper announcements. Please ask for our full list of fees to help you with this decision making.

<p>Burial Fee</p> <p>For an Attended or Unattended burial the typical cost of a burial fee for local resident in a cemetery or burial ground</p>	<p>£500 (Church of England) £1500 (Council cemetery)</p> <p>For a new grave in a cemetery or burial ground you may also need to pay for the plot. For an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee of the memorial (arranged with memorial stone mason of your choice) All graves will also have an interment fee, this is the charge made for digging and closing a new</p>

	grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.
Cremation Fee For an attended cremation funeral, the cremation fee in this local area, the typical cost of a cremation for local residents is	£1050
